On 19.5.2020, the petitioner was ordered to be released on interim bail for a period of four weeks i.e. 19.5.2020 to 17.6.2020 subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Gurugram in order to work out the compromise. However, meanwhile, the petitioner was arrested in another case.

Learned counsel for the complainant while opposing the bail application submitted that the petitioner is wanted in many other cases and he is also declared a proclaimed offender in the present case.

Be that as it may, at this stage, the Court has to look into the allegations in the FIR. Infact, the petitioner himself is the author of the FIR and the learned counsel Mr. D.S.Matya is representing Smt. Poonam

Kataria, who has purchased the property from some other Subash Chand and not the present petitioner, who is having the same name. Moreover, challan has already been filed.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing of bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
