The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail in respect of FIR No.38 dated 11.04.2020, under Sections 323,307,506,34,188,269,270 IPC registered at Police Station City Morinda, District Rupnagar.

Ms. Bhavna Gupta, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view service of advance copy of petition states that as per instructions received by her from ASI Narinder Singh, Police Station City Morinda keeping in view the zimni No.9 dated 17.05.2020, Section 307 IPC has been deleted

from FIR No.38 dated 11.04.2020 and all the other sections of the said FIR are bailable and, therefore, the present petition is not maintainable as of now.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute this position and states that keeping in view the development which has taken place on 17.05.2020 by which Section 307 IPC has been deleted, the petitioner does not press the present petition any further and the same may be disposed off as having been not pressed.
