G.S. SANDHAWALIA, J. (Oral) :-

Case has been taken up through Video-Conferencing by Webex Application, in view of the instructions issued and the prevailing situation.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioners submits that he does not wish to press the petition qua petitioner No.2, Chhinda Singh.

Accordingly, the bail application for the said petitioner is dismissed as withdrawn, at this stage.

Petitioners seek regular bail in FIR No.132 dated 28.10.2019, registered under Sections 323, 324, 34, 307, 148 & 149 IPC, at police station Chhajli, District Sangrur.

Counsel for the petitioners has pointed out that the main accused, Harpal Singh son of petitioner No.1-Ram Singh had given the sword blow on the head of Husanpreet Singh, the complainant and the injured. It is pointed out that the said person has died in a road accident on

11.05.2020 since he was on bail, granted by the Juvenile Court. It is further pointed out that Ram Singh, petitioner No.1 has been granted interim bail, to attend the cremation ceremony of his son and has surrendered thereafter. Qua petitioner No.3, Pappu Singh, kick blows on the back had been attributed when the injured had fallen down.

It is pointed out and substantiated by the counsel for the complainant, Mr.G.S.Sidhu that parties were inter set related and have entered into a compromise. An affidavit (Annexure P-2) of the complainant has also been attached with the petitioner, which is vouched for by Mr.Sidhu.

In such circumstances, since injury no.1, which was declared dangerous to life, which is attributed to Harpal Singh, this Court is of the opinion that petitioners No.1 & 3, Ram Singh and Pappu Singh be released on bail, keeping in view their age and the role attributed by them. They shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ilaka Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sangrur.
