The petition has been taken for hearing through video conference due to Covid-19 pandemic.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail in respect of FIR No. 8 dated 29.01.2020, under Sections 452, 323, 341, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Division No. 2, District Jalandhar.

As per the contention of the petitioner, though he has been named in the FIR but he has not inflicted any injury upon the complainant. Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that as the petitioner has not inflicted any injury upon the complainant, hence he is entitled for the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C.

Prima-facie, petitioner alongwith other two accused, who are yet to be identified, carried out the incident wherein complainant got injured on 28.01.2020. The weapons used in the said incident are also yet to be recovered and the identity of the other two accused is also to be ascertained.

No ground is made out for the grant of benefit of bail under
Section 438 Cr.P.C.

Petition is accordingly dismissed.
