This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via WhatsApp facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner seeks regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.27 dated 29.01.2020 under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sector 39, Chandigarh.

An advance copy of the petition was also served upon UT Chandigarh. Mr. Sumit Jain, learned APP, has joined the proceedings and submits that his instructions are complete.

Petition has been taken up for disposal today itself.

As per prosecution version an alleged recovery of 201 Gms. of Heroin was effected from the petitioner. Petitioner was arrested on 29.01.2020.

Mr. Sumit Jain, learned APP has apprised the Court that

investigation in the case is complete and even the challan has been presented.

Charges are yet to be framed. Trial as such would take time to complete. The alleged recovery from the petitioner is of non-commercial quantity. It stands conceded that the petitioner is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act.

Without making any observation on merit, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petitioner namely Amit Kumar @ Amit Hooda be enlarged on bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Chandigarh.
