1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.67 dated 25.04.2020, registered under Sections 323, 341, 354-B, 148, 149, 506 IPC, at Police Station Guruharsahai, District Ferozepur.
3. Learned counsel states that pursuant to the orders of this Court dated 18.05.2020, the petitioners have joined investigation and fully co-operated with the police, whereafter the petitioners were released on ad-interim bail and their custodial interrogation is not required.
4. Learned AAG, Punjab, on instructions from ASI Jaspal Chand, confirms that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 18.05.2020, the petitioners have joined investigation, were released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail and that their custodial interrogation is not required.

5. In the light of the position as noted above, order dated 18.05.2020, passed by this Court, is made absolute, *qua* the petitioners. The petitioners shall abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

6. Petition disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
