The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 22 dated 27.02.2020 under Sections 420/120-B IPC, P.S. Sadar Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

The operative part of the order dated 18.05.2020, vide which the petitioners have been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are mother-in-law and father-in-law of the complainant Prabhdeep Singh. From the perusal of the FIR, it is clear that there was dispute between husband and wife. There is no specific allegation of the amount having been paid to the petitioners and the case is based on documentary evidence and nothing is to be recovered from the petitioners.

Notice of motion.

Though advance copy of the petition stands already served, Mr. Sandeep Vermani, Addl. AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. He prays for time to seek instructions.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 18.05.2020, have already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on telephonic instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 18.05.2020, are made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
