Due to the outbreak of pandemic COVID-19, the instant case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Vide orders dated 18.05.2020, the Coordinate Bench has allowed interim bail to the accused/petitioner-Ashish.

The learned State counsel has made statement that in consequence of order dated 18.05.2020, the petitioner-Ashish has joined the investigation and that nothing has been recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In light of the statement made by the learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated

18.05.2020 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
