Prayer in this application is for exemption from filing the prescribed Court fee.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed.

Exemption, as prayed for, is granted.

CRWP No.3111 of 2020

Petitioners apprehend threat to their lives and liberty from respondent Nos.4 and 5 and have, therefore, highlighted this position in their representation dated 18.05.2020 (Annexure P-5) addressed to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana-respondent No.2.

Counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent Nos.2 and 3, to look into the representation dated 18.05.2020 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the

Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana-respondent No.2 and S.H.O., Police Station Division No.7, Ludhiana-respondent No.3, to look into the representation dated 18.05.2020 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if required.
