Criminal Misc. No.10821 of 2020:

Prayer in this application filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for exemption from filing Court fee.

Prayer for exemption of Court fee on account of COVID-19 is accepted with the condition that the petitioner shall deposit the required Court fee within a period of one month when the situation becomes normal from the COVID-19 effect.

Application stands disposed of.

Criminal Misc. No.M-12609 of 2020:

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the

petitioners in case FIR No.315 dated 11.09.2019 under Sections 420/447 IPC registered at Police Station Saran, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 21.5.2020 of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforesaid fact and submits that the custody of the petitioner is no more required.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custody is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 21.5.2020 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
