Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.620 dated 08.12.2019 under Sections 120-B, 170, 384, 385, 387, 392, 394, 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Hisar, District Hisar.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 20.05.2020: -

“...Counsel for the petitioner has argued that as per the allegations in the FIR, registered at the instance of 03 persons namely Siraj Mohammad, Aazam Ali and Mosam Ali, on 27.11.2019, their vehicle bearing registration No.HR72-9879 was stopped and an amount of Rs.40,000/- was demanded by the accused party and the same was deposited in the account of co-

accused Satyaparkash. It is further stated in the FIR that a total amount of Rs.12,60,000/- has already been deposited by the complainant in the bank account of the accused persons. It is also submitted that on the face of it, it is a business dispute regarding settlement of accounts. Counsel for the petitioner has relied upon a partnership deed between Yakub Khan and the co-accused Satyaparkash (who is son of the present petitioner Randhir Singh) dated 24.06.2019 and a GPA executed by aforesaid Yakub Khan in favour of the petitioner for running their business.

Counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that Yakub Khan and Mosam Ali complainant, are partners and on that account, the present FIR has been registered with the allegation that the amount has been illegally demanded through all the parties are in the business of selling milk – cattles in Rajasthan, Haryana and Delhi. It is further submitted that 04 of the co-accused namely Karamvir, Azad Singh, Sushila, Satyaparkash and Mandeep have been granted the concession of bail by the courts below.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Chetan Sharma, AAG, Haryana, who is appearing through video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Counsel for the State has argued that the fact about the partnership between Yakub Khan and Mosam Ali is yet to be ascertained during the investigation...”

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Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 20.05.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
