Harnaresh Singh Gill, J.

By way of the present petition, the petitioners pray for issuance of necessary directions to respondent Nos. 1 to 4 to protect their life and liberty stated to be under threat at the hands of respondent Nos.5 to 7.

Admittedly, both the petitioners are married. Respondent No.7-Jasvir Singh is the husband of petitioner No1-Rajvir Kaur. It is the case of the petitioners that petitioner No.1-Rajvir Kaur, owing to her differences/dispute(s) with her husband, wants to live with petitioner No.2-Harpreet Singh, whose wife does not have any objection to it.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, while drawing the attention of this Court to the order dated

13.05.2020 passed in CRWP-3058-2020, states that pursuant to the said order, the petitioners had filed a representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozpur on 15.05.2020, but the same has not been decided till date.

Indisputably, both the petitioners are married. Entertaining the present petition would amount to transgression into the matrimonial chord of the petitioners and bringing the institution of marriage to an end. If the petitioners are not happy with their present matrimonial life, there is a settled statutory provision to seek a legal redress there-against, but in no case start living with another person and then seek protection of life and liberty under the guise of live-in-relationship. The act of the petitioners in jumping the institution of marriage and seeking a self styled way of living is nothing but a misadventure and therefore, they are not entitled to any relief.

Even otherwise, the petitioners withdrew the earlier petition filed by them on the similar facts with liberty to approach the appropriate authorities in District Sangrur, but instead they moved a representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozpur (Annexure P-3). Thus, the petitioners have not complied with the order dated 13.05.2020 passed by this Court.

In view of the above, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is hereby dismissed.
