Through the present second petition filed under Section 439 of the Criminal Procedure Code, the petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.14, dated 04.09.2019, registered under Sections 323, 324, 34, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 307 IPC added later on), at Police Station HSIIDC Barhi, District Sonapat.

2. The petitioner was originally granted bail in the FIR, which was registered under Sections 323, 324, 34 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code. But subsequently, after addition of Section 307 of the Indian Penal Code on 20.09.2019, the petitioner was re-arrested.

3. He has thereafter remained in detention since 23.09.2019. Investigation already completed and challan submitted.
4. Co-accused, namely, Rohit has been released on bail by this Court in CRM-M No.5848 of 2020 on 14.02.2020. Charges against the accused were framed on 14.02.2020. But till date, no evidence from the prosecution side has commenced.
5. In the given circumstances, the indefinite detention of the petitioner, at this stage, is not called for. Therefore, he may be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
6. The petition stands disposed off.
