Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.102 dated 24.04.2020, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 466, 468, 471, 188, 269, 270, 271, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 51, 52 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Police Hoshiarpur.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 21.05.2020, passed the following order:-

“ Contends that petitioner is not the owner of the vehicle and as a matter of fact, the same belongs to one Satnam Singh. Also contends that petitioner has no role to prepare any curfew pass. Further contends that there is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner.

Notice of motion for 14.07.2020.

Mr. L.S.Sofat, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State. In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to join investigation before the investigating officer.

In the event of his arrest, the arresting officer would admit him to interim bail, till the next date of hearing, on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. ”

Contentends that in terms of the above order, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions, has acknowledged that in terms of order dated 21.05.2020, petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, interim order dated 21.05.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is also made clear that petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

Disposed off accordingly.
