The petitioner prays for grant of regular bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.175 dated 23.04.2019 registered under Section 20 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Rajendra Park, District Gurugram.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner alongwith other accused persons were travelling in a motor car being driven by Hari Om and co-accused. They were found in conscious possession of 50.1 Kg *ganja* leaves which falls in the commercial category.

This is second bail application filed by the petitioner for grant of similar relief.

Learned counsel for the State has submitted that the prosecution has already recorded depositions of 9 witnesses out of total 12 proposed to

be examined. He further submits that remaining three witnesses are official witnesses.

Previous bail application filed by the petitioner was disposed of on 20.12.2019 directing the trial Court to conclude the criminal trial within a period of four months.

Due to outbreak of Covid-19, the trial could not be concluded within the aforesaid time.

Learned counsel for the State has submitted that the case is now fixed for 02.06.2020.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner is disposed of by requesting the trial Court to positively conclude the trial within next three months.
