The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

CRM-10825-2020

Prayer in this application filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for exemption from filing the prescribed court fee.

Prayer for exemption of court fee on account of COVID-19 is accepted with the condition that the petitioners shall deposit the required court fee within a period of one month when the situation becomes normal from the COVID-19 effect.

CRM-M-12615-2020

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in FIR No.53 dated 19.01.2020 under Sections 148, 149, 307 IPC, 1860 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959

(during investigation Section 30 was added later on in place of Section 25 of the Arms Act), registered at Police Station Model Town, Panipat, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioners relies upon the order dated 12.05.2020 passed in **CRM-M-12151-2020 (Manjeet Versus State of Haryana)**, whereby co-accused Manjeet has been admitted on regular bail by this Court.

Learned State Counsel does not dispute the fact that co-accused of the petitioners has been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 12.05.2020 passed in CRM-M-12151-2020.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioners are in custody since 20.01.2020, co-accused of the petitioners has been admitted on regular bail by this Court vide order dated 12.05.2020 passed in CRM-M-12151-2020, coupled with the fact that trial in the case will take sufficient long time, this Court deems it appropriate to admit the petitioners on regular bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioners are admitted on regular bail, subject to their furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

It is made clear that the petitioners shall not extend any threat and shall not try to influence any prosecution witnesses directly or indirectly in any manner.
