The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.0156 dated 30.04.2020, under Sections 323, 342, 365, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, district Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is the outcome of a civil dispute between the parties. He also contends that petitioner No. 1 is a 72 years old lady while petitioner No. 2 is a 37 years old lady and only simple injuries are attributed to them.

This Court, by the order dated 21.05.2020, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and the petitioners having joined investigation and not required for custodial interrogation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 21.05.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
