The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 590 dated 8.12.2019, registered under Sections 392, 506, 34 IPC, at Police Station Sector-5, Gurugram.

It is contended by the counsel for the petitioner that the case against the petitioner is totally concocted. The name of the petitioner has been sought to be involved in the case on the basis of disclosure statement of the co-accused, who had already been released on regular bail by the Court. Still further, it is pointed out that the present dispute involves an amount of Rs.500/- only. There is no other case of any kind against the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Munish Sharma, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of
the State of Haryana.

It is submitted by the State counsel that the name of the petitioner has duly surfaced during the investigation. However, it is not disputed that the case involves only Rs.500/-.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds/surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
