On 21.5.2020, the following order was passed by this

Court:-

“The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.242 dated 24.12.2019 registered under Sections 420, 34 IPC, lateron added Sections 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur.

As per the case of the prosecution in the FIR, the petitioner was present when her husband received Rs.8,37,000/- from the first informant while extending false promise of securing a job for the son of the first informant in the police Department.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is a home maker and she has been falsely implicated in this case. He further

submits that the husband of the petitioner is in police custody.

Learned State counsel prays for time to get complete instructions.

Adjourned to 7.8.2020.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jagtar Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the order dated 21.5.2020 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
