Case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

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Allowed as prayed for. Affidavit of complainant-Yasin is taken on record as Annexure P-3, subject to all just exceptions.

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Through this petition, the petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.221 dated 17.06.2010, registered at Police Station Hathin, District Palwal, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324 and 307 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a govt. employee and it is a case of no injury. The present case has been got

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registered by the complainant due to misunderstanding arose between him and the petitioner in the panchayat elections. The learned counsel also relies upon the affidavit dated 01.05.2020 submitted by the the complainant.

Learned State counsel opposes the prayer made in the present petition and submits that the present FIR was registered on 17.06.2010 whereas the petitioner was arrested after almost ten years i.e. 23.03.2020.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In the affidavit (Annexure P-3) submitted by the complainant, it is stated that the petitioner has not caused any injury to him and he does not want to take any action against the petitioner.

Moreover, trial of the case would take time to conclude. Therefore, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and heavy surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
