The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 156 dated 25.03.2020 under Sections 21(b) and 27(a) of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station City Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

The operative part of the order dated 27.05.2020, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, the police party apprehended one Bantu @ Banti and on suspicion, he was given notice under Section 50 of the NDPS Act and, thereafter, a Gazetted Officer was called and 56 grams of heroin was recovered.

Counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that the petitioner is a lady of aged about 50 years. He has further submitted that she is nominated in the FIR on the disclosure of aforesaid Bantu @ Banti and nothing was recovered from her. He has also submitted that the petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case, including the NDPS case.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Chetan Sharma, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, who is appearing through video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the State. He, however,

opposes the prayer on the ground that the allegations against the petitioner are of serious nature.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 27.05.2020, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on telephonic instructions from SI Ranjit Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 27.05.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
