This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.222 dated 24.08.2019, under Sections 22, 25, 29 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station, Sardulgarh, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that no recovery has been effected from the petitioner. He has been involved in this case subsequent upon the disclosure statements made by the co-accused, from whose conscious possession, the recovery was effected.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Balwinder Singh, informs that challan, in the present case, has already been presented and out of 10 prosecution witnesses, 03 have been examined. He further states that the petitioner is not facing any other trial under the NDPS Act.

The petitioner is in custody since 30.01.2020.

Heard.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that the trial will take some time for its conclusion, this Court feels that no purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing of bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Mansa.
