The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this application filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for exemption from filing the prescribed court fee.

Prayer for exemption of court fee on account of COVID-19 is accepted with the condition that the petitioners shall deposit the required court fee within a period of one month when the situation becomes normal from the COVID-19 effect.

Application stands disposed of.

As per vernacular version of the FIR appended with the petition, five packets containing 2.560 KG of Charas were recovered from the possession of the petitioner, but the translated version so attached with

the petition does not indicate the aforesaid recovery from the petitioner.

Thus this Court finds that the FIR has not been property translated.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, in case counsel for the petitioner finds that the observation of the Court as regard the recovery in the translated version of the FIR is not correct, he is at liberty to seek revival of the present petition.
