ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.0058 dated 17.03.2020, under Sections 323/324/34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner who is 19 years old student, is alleged to have caused 'kirpan' blows on the complainant. The complainant has fully recovered from the injuries and the matter has also been compromised. He has referred to the copy of the compromise dated 12.04.2020 which is annexed as Annexure P-2.

This Court, by the order dated 10.06.2020, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation

and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Anwar Masih, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

Heard through video conferencing.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 10.06.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
