1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.41 dated 04.02.2019, registered under Sections 420, 406 and 506 of IPC, 1860, at Police Station Chappar, District Yamuna Nagar.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that vide order dated 23.06.2020, while issuing notice of motion and adjourning the case to 23.07.2020, it was directed that in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. Learned counsel contends that pursuant to the aforementioned order, the petitioner joined investigation and was released on ad-interim bail.

4. Learned DAG, Haryana on instructions from SI Subhash

as well as of his having been released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail on 16.07.2020 and further not being required for custodial interrogation.

5. In the light of the position as noted above, order dated 23.06.2020, passed by this Court, is made absolute, qua the petitioner. The petitioner shall also abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

6. Petition disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
