This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.186 dated 01.12.2019, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'NDPS Act'), registered at Police Station, Arniwala, District Fazilka.

While declining regular bail to the petitioner vide order dated 24.02.2020 (Annexure P-1), Special Court, Fazilka, has observed that there was recovery of 750 tablets containing Tramadol Hydrochloride salt and as per report of chemical examiner, the recovery falls under the commercial category. Petitioner is in custody since 01.12.2019.

Keeping in view that the recovery, effected from the petitioner, falls under the commercial category, no case for grant of regular bail is made out.

Dismissed.
