All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Pursuant to the order dated May 28, 2020, admitting the petitioner to pre-arrest bail, subject to his joining investigation, learned counsel for the State submits that the petitioner has since joined investigation and that his custodial interrogation is not required, as per instructions received from SI Baldev Singh.

Consequently, in view of the above and the reasons given in the order dated May 28, 2020, this petition is allowed with the said order made

absolute.
