The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 22 dated 27.02.2020 under Sections 420/120-B IPC, P.S. Sadar Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

The operative part of the order dated 27.05.2020, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is brother-in-law (brother of the wife) of complainant-Prabhdeep Singh. The marriage of Prabhdeep Singh was performed with the sister of petitioner Harjeet Kaur on 9.4.2017, thereafter, she went to Canada for higher studies. He has further submitted that as per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner has paid some amount as sponsorship for the higher studies of his wife and when he had gone to Canada on 27.12.2019, he found that she is living with another person and the complainant returned back.

Counsel for the petitioner further submits that there is no direct allegations against the petitioner and even the

parents of the petitioner has already been granted the concession of anticipatory bail vide order dated 18.5.2020 passed in CRM-M-12527-2020.

At this stage, Mr. Manjinder Singh Bhullar, Advocate appears and accepts notice on behalf of the complainant.

List again on 13.07.2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 27.05.2020, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on telephonic instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 27.05.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
