This is an application for exemption from affixing the Court fee and welfare fund ticket on the main petition.

For the reasons given in the application, the applicant-petitioners are granted exemption from filing the Court fee and welfare fund ticket for the time being with the further direction that the same shall be made good once the pandemic situation is over.

The application is disposed of.

Case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of direction to respondents

No.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them in any manner at the hands of respondents No.5 to 9.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Manish Bansal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners, who are major, have married against the wishes of private respondents. They apprehend danger from the private respondents and seek protection to their life and liberty. The *Nikahnama* evidencing their marriage has been placed on record as Annexure 2. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 11.05.2020 (Annexure P-1) to respondent No.2.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the present petition with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation (Annexure P-1) moved by the petitioners and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.
