By way of this writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner herein states that he has been served with an order dated 11.02.2020, which has already been challenged by the petitioner and an appeal under Section 79 of the Haryana Registration and Regulation of Societies Act, 2012 is pending before the Registrar of Firms and Societies, Haryana at Chandigarh. However, despite the pendency of the appeal, he has been directed by letter dated 13.05.2020, which is Annexure P-21 on record, for compliance of the order dated 11.02.2020.

Counsel for the petitioner herein has a limited prayer by way of this writ petition for staying operation of the letter dated 13.05.2020 (Annexure P-21) till such time as the appeal is decided.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Shruti Jain Goyal, Addl. A.G., Haryana, who is present through the medium of Video Conferencing, accepts notice for official respondents.

Counsel appearing for the respondent-State would submit that at the present moment, during the outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic, some offices of State Government are not functioning, however, she states that the appeal will be decided as expeditiously as possible.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without going into merits of the case and in view of the fact that an appeal has already been filed, let the same be decided within a period of three months from today and till such time as any decision is taken on the appeal, the impugned letter dated 13.05.2020 (Annexure P-21) shall be kept in abeyance.

The writ petition stands disposed of on this limited point.
