The learned State counsel has made statement that petitioner in compliance of order dated 29.06.2020 has joined the investigation which could not be displaced by the learned State counsel assisted by counsel for the complainant and that nothing is to be recovered from him.

29.06.2020 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
