The matter has been taken up through video conferencing in the light of the pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The petitioner seeks release on parole enabling him to get conducted surgery upon his aged mother, Baljit Kaur as well as agriculture parole.

Learned counsel contends that mother of the petitioner has been advised third surgery for Ileostomy Clouse and there is no other male member in the family to look after her. He also intends to carry out agricultural work. Therefore, he prays for grant of parole for six weeks.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner is a habitual offender. He has been involved in a number of

criminal cases.

Heard.

A perusal of the custody certificate reveals that the petitioner is a habitual offender and has been convicted in a number of criminal cases, therefore, there is strong apprehension in the mind of the Court that in the eventuality of his release from the jail, he is likely to misuse the concession. Further, except the bald assertion, there is nothing on record to show ownership of the land and that there is no other male member in the family to look after the patient.

Keeping in view the antecedents of the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to accept the prayer.

Dismissed.
