Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct a fair and impartial investigation in case FIR No.3 dated 05.01.2018 registered under Sections 363/366-A/120-B of IPC and Section 6 of POCSO Act, 2012 at Police Station Sadar, Amritsar.

Learned State counsel states that on 16.09.2019 when status report was submitted, the status in the case was as under:-

“7. That it is humbly submitted that challan of the present case/FIR No.03 dated 05.01.2018, under Sections 363, 366A, 376 IPC, 3, 4, 6 of POCSO Act, Police Station Sadar, Amritsar against the PO Kamal Singh has been prepared by the SHO PS Sadar, Amritsar, which shall soon be presented before the Court of Ld. Illaqa Magistrate. However, directions have been issued to SHO PS Sadar, Amritsar and Investigating Officer for arrest of PO Kamal Singh.”

Now learned State counsel has the instructions to state that the investigation in the case is over and as against 6 accused named by the complainant, 5 have been found innocent whereas the accused Kamal Singh has been declared proclaimed offender.

In view of above, present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed as such.
