All the cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

By this petition file under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks the concession of bail upon FIR no.0813, dated 15.10.2019, having been registered against him, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 148, 149, 323 and 307 of the IPC and Sections 25-54-59 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Nuh, District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the only allegation against the petitioner is that during the course of pelting of stones against the complainant party, he too pelted stones/bricks, with the gun shot attributed to one Abdulla. He further submits that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, very fairly submits that

the only allegation against the petitioner is of pelting of stones and that he has been in custody for the past 6 months, with him, however, having no instructions with regard to any compromise effected between the parties.

However, Mr. Khalid, Advocate, appears for the complainant and admits the factum of the compromise between the parties.

In view of the above, without making any comment on the merits of the case, for or against the petitioner, this petition is allowed.

Consequently, the petitioner would be enlarged on bail, upon his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
