The matter has been taken up through Video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Counsel for respondent no. 2-Insurance Company after getting instructions has made statement that the Insurance Company is willing to pay Rs 20,000/- over and above the award amount of Rs 2,18,470/- inclusive of interest till date. Counsel for the appellant, after getting instructions has made statement agreeing to this settlement. In the light of the same, respondent no. 2 shall be bound to pay the amount within 45 days from today and which has been undertaken by counsel for respondent no. 2 to abide

by this settlement. The amount be deposited before the Commissioner, Workmen's Compensation Act, Karnal who will ensure disbursal of the amount to the beneficiaries. In view of this settlement, counsel for the appellants has made statement withdrawing the present appeal. Allowed to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
