The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case bearing FIR No.0006 dated 28.01.2020 registered under Sections 399, 402 IPC and under Section 25 of Arms Act at Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka.

Allegations are of preparing and planning to commit dacoity by all the accused namely Ajay Kumar son of Lal Chand, Ajay Singh son of Karaj Singh, Lakhwinder Singh son of Baldev Singh, Sukhdev Singh @ Divam son of Darshan Singh and the petitioner. They were shown sitting under a kikar tree and were preparing and planning to commit a dacoity in a big way. They were allegedly armed with weapons.

The FIR in question was registered on the basis of secret information and thereafter, petitioner along with others was arrested. An iron sword has been recovered from the petitioner.

Petitioner was arrested on 28.01.2020 and since then, he is in judicial custody.

Learned State counsel submits that challan has been presented, but no prosecution witness has been examined so far.

Taking into consideration the totality of facts and circumstances of the case, petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/concerned Duty Magistrate.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an opinion on the merits of the case.
