The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case bearing FIR No.133 dated 10.06.2019 registered under Sections 22(c) and 27(a) of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act at Police Station Rattia, District Fatehabad, Haryana.

Petitioner has been nominated as an accused in the present case on the basis of second disclosure statement of co-accused Kuldeep Singh @ Happy, who has already been granted anticipatory bail in CRM-M No.28480 of 2019.

Kuldeep Singh has been shown by the name of Happy son of Jaswant @ Billu.

Since the complicity of the petitioner is based on second disclosure statement of co-accused, therefore, complicity of the petitioner would remain debatable.

Petitioner is in custody since 05.08.2019. Challan has been presented, but no prosecution witness has been examined so far.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner is involved in other cases of NDPS Act. The law will take its own course in respect of complicity of the petitioner in other cases.

For the reasons recorded hereinabove, petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/concerned Duty Magistrate.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an opinion on the merits of the case.
