The present writ petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus and for appointment of a Warrant Officer, with a roving writ to search for the detenues mentioned in para No.3 of the petition at the premises of the brick kiln of respondents No.4 to 6 or at any other place to be pointed out by the petitioner and get them released from their illegal custody.

Accordingly, vide order dated 22.5.2020 the Deputy Commissioner, Ambala was directed to look into the matter and have the detenues released in case they are found in illegal detention at the premises of the brick kiln of respondents No. 4 to 6.

Report of Sub Divisional Magistrate, Naraingarh dated 29.5.2020 has been received. As per the said report, the labourers as named in the aid report had gone to their native village and they were not

present at the brick kiln. They were also provided all the facilities while living in the brick kiln. However, only four of them as mentioned in the report were found to be present but they too stated that they were staying there out of free will and were free to move any where they wanted. They too were granted the vehicle permission to go to their native place.

In view of the above report, the present petition is disposed of as rendered infructuous.

However, in case the petitioners are still aggrieved in any manner, they are at liberty to avail the remedy as available under the law.
