In the instant case, 500 tablets of Tramadol hydrochloride and 05 grams of Heroin have been recovered from the possession of the petitioner on 20.09.2019. The quantity of 500 tablets of Tramadol hydrochloride recovered from the possession of the petitioner falls in the category of commercial quantity.

As such, the stringent provisions of Section 37 of NDPS Act come into play. There is nothing to suggest that the petitioner has not committed the offence and is not likely to commit the offence while on bail.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
