Through the present petition the petitioners seek the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.44 dated 14.04.2020, registered under Sections 379, 323, 341, 506, 188, 34 IPC and Section 27 of Arms Act 1959 at Police Station Rahon, District SBS Nagar.

Learned State counsel submits that in pursuance to the interim order of this Court the petitioners have not only joined the investigation but have also fully cooperated with the investigating agency and that their custodial interrogation is no longer required by the State.

In view of the above statement made by learned State counsel, the order of this Court dated 29.05.2020, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners is made absolute.
