As regards, petitioner No.1 - Seema Tarar, she is
relegated to the remedy of approaching the trial Court and to raise all the
pleas there at appropriate stage.

As regards, petitioner No.2 – Abhimanyu Sharma, he
is directed to surrender in the trial Court within one week. On his doing
so and moving application for regular bail, the same be decided within

two weeks. Till then, petitioner No.2 – Abhimanyu Sharma may not be arrested. However, this order is subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) he shall appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing;
- (ii) he shall not give any threat or intimidation to the prosecution witnesses; and
- (iii) he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court and shall surrender his passport.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
