The petitioner prays for grant of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.123 dated 1.10.2019 registered under Section 15 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Nurpur Bedi, Police Station.

In a nutshell, case of the prosecution is that on receipt of the secret information a barrier was laid and the petitioner was found transporting 300 kg poppy husk in a truck. The petitioner was apprehended at the spot whereas other co-accused fled away.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner has been falsely implicated and he was arrested from his house.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State on telephonic instructions from ASI Deepak Kumar, has submitted that huge quantity of narcotics i.e 300 kg poppy husk has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner.

In this case on completion of the investigation, police report under Section 173 Cr.P.C has been filed. The Court has also framed charges against the accused on 16.3.2020. The case is likely to come up

for prosecution evidence on 22.6.2020.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of bail to the petitioner. However, learned Trial Court is requested to make sincere endeavour for disposal of the trial within six months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
