The petitioner seeks regular bail in a petition filed under
Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No. 132 dated 13.05.2020 under Sections
323/325/34/506 IPC, P.S. Sector 14, Panchkula.

On 05.06.2020, the following order was passed:-

*“The matter has been taken up by way of Video
Conferencing in view of COVID-19 situation, as per
instructions issued.*

*Mr. Sharma, submits that in pursuance of the
earlier order passed on 01.06.2020, it was confirmed
from the law officer who had appeared in the connected
matter i.e. CRM-M-13317-2020 that whether the issue
of wrong translation of FIR as such was brought to the
notice of the Bench, which had granted anticipatory
bail to the coaccused Gurjant Singh @ Noni. It is
submitted that the said factum has been confirmed that*

the Bench was duly apprised and thereafter passed the order on merits. Keeping in view the above, this Court does not propose to further go into the issue, which was noticed on 01.06.2020.

As per the vernacular of the FIR, the allegations were against Gurjant Singh @ Noni who had used the Sword.

In such circumstances, it is directed that the petitioner shall join investigation and in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on ad-interim bail by the investigating officer, as it is pointed out that co-accused has joined investigation in pursuance of the order dated 29.05.2020 in the connected matter. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when required and shall comply with the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

To come up on 25.08.2020.”

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation, which fact has been vouched for by counsel the State, on instructions from ASI Jasbir.

Accordingly, order dated 05.06.2020 is confirmed and the petition stands disposed of.
