Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking regular bail in case FIR No. 217 dated 13.11.2019 under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar Nabha, District Patiala.

Briefly, the aforesaid FIR has been registered on the allegation of recovery of 640 tablets of Tramadol Hydrochloride from the possession of the petitioner. It has been pointed out that quantity of Tramadol Hydrochloride comes to 258.56 grams which is marginally above the commercial quantity.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the arrest of the petitioner was effected as back as on 13.11.2019, investigation of the case is complete, challan has already been presented in the Court and the petitioner is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the aforesaid fact(s).

In these set of circumstances, sufficient grounds are made out to extend the concession of bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
