The present petition is filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of regular bail in FIR No.153 dated 7.7.2019 under Section 302, 34 of IPC, Police Station Salem Tabri, District Police Commissionrate Ludhiana.

While opposing the bail application, learned counsel for the respondent-State submitted that there is a specific allegation against the petitioner of causing injury.

Heard.

A perusal of the FIR shows that it is case of sudden fight and injuries are as mentioned in the post mortem report are simple in nature and the death also is stated to be on account of cardio pulmonary arrest due to combined effect of chronic heard disease, venous congestion of lungs, lever and injuries as mentioned in the PMR report.

In these circumstances, it is yet to be determined as to whether the case falls under Section 302 IPC.

In view of the above, this Court deems it proper to release the

petitioner on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

The petition stands disposed of.
