The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.131 dated 09.05.2020, under Section 15 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar Sirsa, Haryana.

State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit dated 24.08.2020 of Sanjay Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sirsa on behalf of the respondent. In para 8 of the affidavit, it has been deposed that investigation from the present petitioner, namely, Baljeet @ Baljeet Singh, has been completed. Details of the statement of the petitioner recorded by the investigating agency have also been given in the said affidavit.

State counsel, on instructions from SI Ram Kumar, has submitted that in pursuance of order dated 08.06.2020, petitioner has already joined the investigation and is no longer required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 08.06.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
