Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 186 dated 10.09.2019 registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 324, 307, 506 and 34 IPC at Police Station Sector-36, District U.T. Chandigarh.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner was involved in 6 other cases wherein he is on bail. It has been further pointed out that now at this stage compromise dated 15.05.2020 has been executed between the complainant and the petitioner. Co-accused Vikas Kumar has been granted regular bail vide order dated 18.12.2019 and co-accused Dharminder has been granted interim bail vide order dated 21.05.2020 till the next date of hearing i.e. 05.08.2020. The petitioner has been in custody since 10.09.2019.

Learned APP, UT Chandigarh has opposed the bail on the fact that the petitioner had inflicted Kirpan blow on the neck of the complainant and the Sword has been recovered from him.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In the present case, compromise has been effected between the complainant and petitioner. The co-accused have already been granted bail. The petitioner has been in custody since 10.09.2019. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
