Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner as also learned counsel for the State and the complainant, looking at the nature of the allegation, especially the fact that the petitioner earlier is stated to have entered into a compromise (in the year 2017) to the effect that he would not beat his wife in future and would pay her Rs.3000/- per month for her expenses, without making any comment on the actual merit of the case (which naturally would be gone into by the trial court as per evidence led before it), I see no reason to entertain this petition, at this stage.
