Status report dated 01.07.2020 has been filed on behalf of the State. The same is taken on record.

According to the aforementioned report, the error in the batch number has been corrected vide order dated 26.06.2020, a copy of which has been annexed as Annexure R-1 with the status report.

Learned counsel for the petitioner insists that the case foisted upon the petitioner is false. The petitioner has been in custody for over 04 months and thus, he deserves to be released on regular bail.

The argument of learned counsel for the petitioner is misconceived. Once correction in order dated 27.02.2020 has been ordered by the trial Court vide its order dated 26.06.2020 it cannot be said that the case against the petitioner is false. The error in the batch number has been corrected and cogent reasons have been given therefor.

Commercial quantity of narcotic drugs has been recovered and thus, at this stage I see no valid ground for accepting the request of the petitioner.

The petition is accordingly dismissed.
