[1] Prayer in the petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing of order, Annexure P/5 dated 12.02.2019 passed by respondent No.3 terminating the services of the petitioner etc.

[2] Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset states that the petitioner has filed an appeal, Annexure P/6 dated 15.06.2019 against order, Annexure P/5 dated 12.02.2019 before respondent No.2 but the same has not been decided till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the appeal, Annexure P/6 expeditiously in a time bound manner.

[3] Notice of motion.

[4] Mr. Hitesh Pandit, learned Addl, A.G., Haryana, who is present, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner.

[5] In view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the appeal, Annexure P/6 dated 15.06.2019 in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of three months from the date of resumption of work in the office of respondent No.2.
